A Call to Action

It is almost three years since I was Installed as Provincial Prior, and in June I will preside over my fourth Provincial Meeting. During this time I have made a number of small changes to the Provincial Appointments and have now instituted a Provincial Malta meeting. On the downside we have lost the Preceptory of Charity and plans to re-institute a Bodyguard Preceptory have been shelved due to lack of interest. Recruitment is holding steady although it is patchy across the Province. If all Preceptories could match de L'Isle Adam 234 with four candidates in each of two consecutive years we would be in a very strong position. In Cheshire Royal Arch Companions outnumber KT Knights by around 8 to 1.

So there is much still to do and the Sub-Prior and I, together with the Province's senior officers will maintain our high visibility and continue to promote the United Orders. However the major effort needs to come from individual Knights in their

THE 2016 PROVINCIAL MALTA MEETING

Arrangements have now been made for a Cheshire & North Wales Malta Meeting to be held at Christleton on Monday 31st October 2016 at 6pm. There will be a Festive Board but no visitors from other Provinces.

In 2016, and in future years, Provincial Officers will be appointed to their new Temple ranks in June, and to their equivalent Malta ranks in October. At the Malta meeting there will be a Candidate Installed into Malta and in 2016 this will be Kt Michael Leese of Temple Preceptory who is the Craft Provincial Grand Secretary for Cheshire. The Provincial Malta Officers who were appointed in 2015 will take their places at the tables with the Provincial Sub-Prior acting as Prior. The Provincial Prior will deliver the address. While the Candidate is in the Guard Room the Provincial Prior will appoint and promote the Officers for the ensuing year.

This meeting does not in any way change the arrangements individual Preceptories have for dealing with Malta Candidates. It does however give the Malta Officers appropriate prominence and demonstrates the important role the Order of St John has in our United Orders.

Table Officers are encouraged to wear Malta Regalia if possible and you are all reminded that Malta Provincial mantle badges are now available for all ranks. They should be positioned ABOVE the Maltese Cross on the Mantle and NOT on its centre.

The formal Summons for this meeting will be issued by the Provincial Vice-Chancellor via Registrars in due course.

In the Temple meeting in June we have a delegation from the Malta degree. In The Malta meeting we will have a corresponding Temple delegation which will be composed of six Great Priory Officers.

For your diaries, the Malta meetings in 2017 and 2018 will be held on Tuesday 31st October 2017 and Wednesday 31st October 2018.

You should also have agreed with your Registrar the name of the Banner Bearer and, if required, that of the member of the Malta Delegation. You must attend yourself or be represented by a member of your Preceptory.

CHANGES IN THE LEADSHIP OF THE PROVINCE

On 4th June 2016 there will be a number of significant changes in the Leadership of the Province.

E Kt (soon to be V E Kt) John Lightfoot has asked to retire from his position as Provincial Chancellor. John has been in active office in the Province for many years having been Deputy Provincial Marshall and Provincial Marshall before becoming Chancellor. He has provided successive Provincial Priors with much wise advise and support and has given much input into the General Purposes Committee. John will continue to represent the Provincial Prior at Installations.

E Kt Philip Broadhurst will be appointed Provincial Chancellor following on from his time as Provincial Marshal and Deputy Marshal. Philip has delivered the ceremonial of the Province to a very high and enviable standard both at the Annual Meeting and at Team Visits. As Chancellor his wise counsel will continue to be available for some time to come.

E Kt Fraser Fowlie will be appointed Provincial Marshal. He has been Deputy Marshal and Commander of the Bodyguard and has spent the last year accompanying the Provincial Prior and Sub-Prior around the country to gather information about how things are done elsewhere. The Province continues to be most grateful to E Kt Bill Caren for all his work as a Provincial Deputy Marshal while shouldering his heavy responsibilities as DC of the Cheshire Province of Mark Master Masons and Royal Ark Mariners.

E Kt Peter Butler will be appointed to the second Provincial Deputy Marshal post and this will give us the opportunity to 'blood' a new Marshal.

E Kt Mike Steggles will assume the position of Deputy Commander of the Bodyguard following the retirement of E Kt Kevin Talbot after three years in office. We are grateful to Kevin for his contribution despite some significant difficulties in his professional life.

ACTING PROVINCIAL CONSTABLES

From June 2016 there will be a change in procedure. A First and Second Constable will be appointed in 2016 but in 2017 the Second Constable will be promoted to First Constable and a new Second Constable appointed.

This change will allow move flexibility when the Provincial Prior is considering recommendations to the M E & S Grand Master for appointments to Great Priory Rank. Currently the Province is allocated three new appointments and one promotion although in certain circumstances two appointments and two promotions will be considered. In future (but not immediately) it will be possible to consider more Great Priory recommendations for Eminent Knights who have not been acting Constables.
